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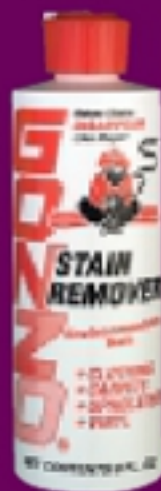


ask the editors

shoe cleaner
like Gonzo—or

with a bit of water.
Scrub the shoes
with a sponge

then dab with a
wet paper towel
and set them
out to dry.
